# AAB Appointments and Handover

- AAB was founded in 2018
- Chair and vice chair tenures are ending in September (2 years) focus is on the new appointments and handover process
- Changes in the way that the board is run which will be in a more formal manner
  - This has been agreed and confirmed by the University and the new structure will come into effect in September 2023
  - Aim is to ease the workload by having school specific board members to take on responsibilities

# New AAB Structure

- There will be 6 members will be aligned to the 6 UEL schools
  - Allows for AAB to integrate into the university, as each school is also creating an Advisory Board with space for a UEL Alum
  - Board acts a sounding board for the university allows more alumni to become more active
- Meetings will be held on a quarterly basis
  - o Members to attend when they can across the year
- Collaborating with an External Agent to work with AAB Terms of Reference and T&C's which will be posted in advance of appointments being advertised – should have an update by next AAB meeting in June

# Work around Recent Graduates

- Graduate Outcomes Survey sent to 'Post 18 month' graduates
  - o Getting feedback and to learn about what our graduates are doing
    - 59.72% in graduate level job

# AAB Meeting Minutes | Thursday 23<sup>rd</sup> March 2023

- Remaining potentially need help from us aim to create activities to help them get into graduate level employment
- 51% didn't think their qualification links with what they are currently doing
- 60% agree that their current activity fits with future plans
- 70% say that their current activity is meaningful
