A reminder about the Graduate Outcomes Survey

You may remember we shared information in previous e-newsletters for our 2019 graduates about the current Graduate Outcomes survey. This is just to remind you to keep an eye out for the Graduate Outcomes team who may be in touch with you to collect your feedback.

This is a national survey capturing the activities and perspectives of graduates, launched in 2018 and is the biggest annual social survey in the UK. We need your responses to this survey to allow current and future students to make

informed choices and to help us to evaluate and promote our courses. The survey only takes 10 minutes to complete online and you can access it on any device.

The survey is delivered by the Graduate Outcomes team which is part of the Higher Education Statistics Agency (HESA) on behalf of the higher education funding and regulatory bodies and higher education providers. The funding and regulatory bodies commission the Graduate Outcomes survey and require HESA and higher education providers to work together to deliver the survey. HESA have published privacy information for students on how your contact details will be used which you can read by **clicking here.**

This means the communications may not look like they are coming from the University of East London, but please rest assured the survey is authentic and we hope if you are contacted you will take the time to complete it and make a change for future University of East London students.
