You must focus on:

- (a) The purpose of the text.
- (b) The identification of key ideas and/or competing arguments.
- (c) The identification of subsidiary information.
- (d) The development of your own ideas resulting from the interaction with the text.
- (e) Clear articulation of your arguments verbally* and in a written style.
- (f) The use of grammar, vocabulary, and punctuation.
- (g) The adherence to the academic writing conventions in relation to argumentation, coherence, cohesion and referencing.

- 4. Use Calibri or Times New Roman font, point 12, 1.5 space between lines.
- 5. Add a word count below the title.
