I will do so for the required period of time, and/or if I begin to suffer with Covid-19 symptoms, I will alert my flatmates immediately, report this and follow guidance to self-isolate outlined on our intranet pages.
- I accept that I should make the areas where we live, work, and study as safe as they can be, and will use the <u>resources and support</u> which the University has made available.
- I understand that during these uncertain times, I may need to self-isolate or that additional lockdowns
 may occur. I will make sure Residential Life have correct contact details and will be aware of how to
 contact Residential Life and Security as outlined below.
- I understand the importance of supporting and looking out for others, especially in these uncertain times. I will look out for my friends and those I live with.
- I acknowledge that I may not know other people's personal circumstances and that it's therefore important that I follow the appropriate guidance and respond positively to the concerns of others. If I have a concern about someone, I will raise this via email (or in an emergency as outlined below) to Residential Life so help and support can be offered.
- I understand that by following the above I am helping create a safe and enjoyable experience for all residents.
