Prepare a solo demonstration that best showcases the versatile ways that you move as a dancer.

Guidance Notes: We encourage you to be creative and innovative, and we expect to see basic dance principles including but not limited to: a solid understanding of movement principles and body control/articulation, musicality, a range of interesting and varied movement dynamics, and solid performance skills. In the creation of this solo, we invite you to share any style of movement that feels most comfortable to you. The solo can be structured (or pre-choreographed), semi-structured (with some elements of set choreography and some moments of freestyle or improvisation) or improvised/freestyle based, depending on your dance training and background.
