



DATA INFORMATION SHEET

Information on access and use of demographic and attainment data in UEL's HEFCE funded Learning Gain Study.

We will be accessing UEL's demographic and attainment data on students who participate in our study. This will include information on ethnicity, gender, disability, social economic data, postcode, previous education, entry tariff information, parental education and UEL attainment data. We will use this demographic and attainment data to analyse trends and patterns amongst the students we are surveying in order to better understand the survey data and to make recommendations about learning gain. Within any reports we produce all data will be anonymised and individual students will not be identifiable.

Confidentiality of the Data

The data (demographic information, attainment data, completed questionnaires, participation in audio recordings and transcripts of interviews and focus group meetings) will be stored on a password-protected computer at the University of East London. All forms will be anonymised and codes/pseudonyms will be assigned to participants in any transcripts. The data will be destroyed after a period of seven years.
