They can help them register with a local GP or clinic, access specialist services, receive medical advice, and apply for free prescriptions, eye tests and dental care as well as signposting to other services, including housing advice, destitution support and specialist counselling. Doctors of the World's main clinic is in Stratford, East London and to reach excluded people who do not or cannot come to the clinic, it sends medics to treat patients at other organisations that help vulnerable migrants across London in their "pop-up clinics." It also runs Women and Children's clinic to meet the particular needs of women and children.
