Module Description

The Practice Education Stage 1 & 2 is for experienced social workers who want to develop skills and knowledge in supervising and assessing students on BA and MA qualifying social work programmes. In line with current practice frameworks, the teaching and assessment on the module is based around the BASW Practice Educator Professional Standards (PEPs).

The module offers:

- 1. An introduction to the experience of negotiating and managing a period of practice education with a student social worker.
- 2. An exploration of the key practical, theoretical and ethical considerations for inducting, supervising, teaching and assessing a student social worker.
- 3. The opportunity to develop knowledge and skills in relation to supervision, the enabling of learning and a fair and transparent approach

to the assessment of a student social worker.

- 4. The facilitation of a reflective learning space on the experiences of supervision, enabling learning and assessment, keeping the service user at the centre.
- 5. The opportunity to explore the Practice Educator Professional Standards values statement and anti-oppressive practice education within the context of the supervisory relationship.
- 6. The facilitation of a reflective learning space to explore the ongoing role as a practice educator, including working with other social work students and mentoring/supporting newly qualified social workers as relevant to particular organisational contexts.

Eligibility Criteria for applications:

- Social work qualification and Social Work England registration.
- At least two years post qualifying experience at the point of application.

Teaching and Learning:

The course is a **10**-day taught course, including a blend of classroom teaching and online learning.

Trainee practice educators are also required to attend and participate in one of the following:

- BA or MA Readiness to Practice Module teaching for student assessed role plays.
- One Practice Assessment Panel (PAP) meeting in either February, March, April, May or June, which includes quality assuring a student portfolio before the meeting.
- Either activity requires a time commitment of half a day, inclusive of preparation.

Employer Requirements

- To host a final year placement for 100 days for a BA or MA UEL student.
- To allocate a Practice Assessor for the trainee practice educator. The Practice Assessor must observe the trainee practice educator a minimum of two times – supervising, teaching and assessing the social work student in accordance with the PEPS domains A – D.

Assessment

The module assessment consists of two portfolios:

For September Start, this comprises one submitted at the end of November, and one at the beginning of June; for December Start, one submission in February, and the final at the end of July. The final portfolio must include evidence in the practice assessor reports to demonstrate that the trainee practice educator has met the PEPs domains.
