

PRE-ENTRY PROGRAMMES

The eligibility test is designed to test your suitability for a Pre-Entry course and undergraduate study. Here are some ways you can prepare to give yourself the best chance to pass. The test has two parts.

PART 1

The personal statement is free-writing about you, your skills, education and future plans. You'll be guided by four questions and should aim to write approximately 100 words (between 8-10 lines) for each question without significantly repeating yourself.

To prepare: think about what you're good at and what you want to learn from the Pre-Entry Short Course and undergraduate courses. You should also think about your future plans.

PART 2

The comprehension task involves reading about a current social topic and answering a series of related questions. If you are taking an entry test for the Law Short Course the topic will be an area of Law, but you will not need any specialist knowledge.

The answers to the majority of the questions will be found in the text. You may also be asked to put forward an opinion about the topic.

To prepare: regularly read quality newspaper articles, such as those in The Guardian, The Times, The Telegraph and The Independent. Talk to friends and family about what you've read and your opinions about the content. You don't have to read the whole newspaper.

Newspapers are free to read in public libraries and articles are also available online. You can also listen to topical discussion programmes on TV, online and on the radio.
