UNDERGRADUATE SCHOLARSHIPS

The following non-repayable scholarships are available for new students starting in 2023/2024 via a competitive application. Scholarships are awarded based on a combination of merit and need.

- Vice-Chancellors Scholarship (£27,750 over course duration)
- Dean Scholarship (£13,500 over course duration)
- ELSEF Scholarship (£1,000 in the first year only)
- UTC Scholarship (£1,500 in the first year only)
- Sports Scholarships (Up to £6,000 per year)

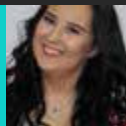

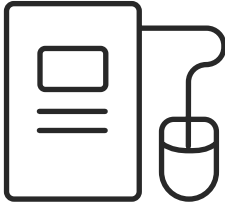


HOW WE TEACH

That's why our teaching model is designed to deliver a dynamic and fulfilling learning experience.

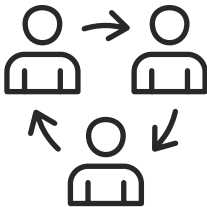




Through our Virtual Learning Environment, you can access lectures, notes, readings, and other online sources to keep learning even when classes aren't happening.



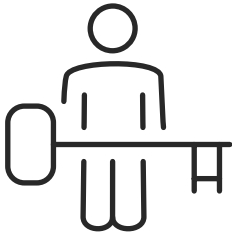
Allocated time for sport, volunteering, and career development. Plus, you have leading clubs and societies which are great for personal growth and you'll also get to enjoy yourself in the process!
